



What does the subsidy cover?

A one-time subsidy up to a maximum of **\$2,725.00** is available. Please see the table below for a breakdown of the maximum allowance.

Subsidized Item / Work	Includes Costs For:	Percentage of Total Cost / Maximum Reimbursement
Weeping Tile Disconnection / Sump Pump System	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Disconnection of the weeping tiles/foundation drains from the sanitary sewer system. • Purchase & installation of a <u>sump pump system</u>; to receive storm water from the weeping tiles and to direct water to suitable location away from home. • Covers costs for materials, labour, permit & taxes. 	Subsidy is for ½ of the invoiced total by contractor up to a maximum of \$1,800.00 .
Disconnection of Downspouts	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Costs associated with redirecting <u>downspouts</u> away from home and to cap the existing pipe leading to the weeping tiles at the side of the home. 	Subsidy is for ½ of all costs up to a maximum of \$250.00 .
*Backwater Valve	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Purchase & installation of suitably sized <u>Mainline Fullport Backwater Valve</u> (with clear cover); to prevent sewage flows from backing up into the basement. • Covers costs for materials, labour, permit & taxes. 	Subsidy is for ½ of the invoiced total by contractor up to a maximum of \$675.00 .

* Homeowners will only qualify for this subsidy if they have demonstrated they do not have any downspout or weeping tile/foundation drain connections to the sanitary sewer or coinciding with measures to eliminate these connections.
